
Who: Every student will receive a Chromebook

 - History

What is a Chromebook?



How does it work?



A Chromebook is a laptop that works in the "cloud"

- Access apps and resources online
- Lots of storage online, limited storage on the computer
- Every student has a school email / Google account for use with a Chromebook

How does it work?



A Chromebook also works without the internet.

- Students complete assignments using their Google Drive off-line.
- These assignments are synched with the online Google drive when students are online.

In a Language Arts class...

Examples of how Chromebooks are used:

- Students create projects using Google Docs
- Students peer-edit each other's work
- Teachers provide realtime feedback to students (written or audio)



In a Science class...

Examples of how Chromebooks are used:

- Students run simulations
- Teachers create "flipped" lessons demonstrating disections, reactions, etc.
- Students co-create lab reports



In a History class...

Examples of how Chromebooks are used:

- Access online databases for research
- View primary source documents
- Create and share projects

Protective Case

\$44 per year


