Hurricane Michael is a hurricane formed on October 7th, 2018. The hurricane was classified as a Category 4 hurricane. This means that the winds were from 130–156 mph. A hurricane like this is capable of tearing off roots and breaking down houses. The damage would be described as “catastrophic”.

In Tallahassee, Florida, Hurricane Michael struck and destroyed property. Due to this, the economy is growing at a slow place and \$233,000,000 has disappeared that was likely to become the budget for Florida for 2019–2020. Florida is currently trying to gather the losses the hurricane caused. All together, Hurricane Michael has destroyed a little less than \$15 billion in 9 days. At least 35 lives were taken because of the hurricane.

Slowly, the country is recovering the damage caused by the storm. During the Hurricane, it knocked out the power supply but luckily, power has been reestablished to Florida on November 6th. Tallahassee teamed up with 44 insurance companies to recover the losses. The Federal Emergency Management Agency are trying to assist the residence that’s suffered. With enough time, Florida will become renewed and become a thriving state again.




